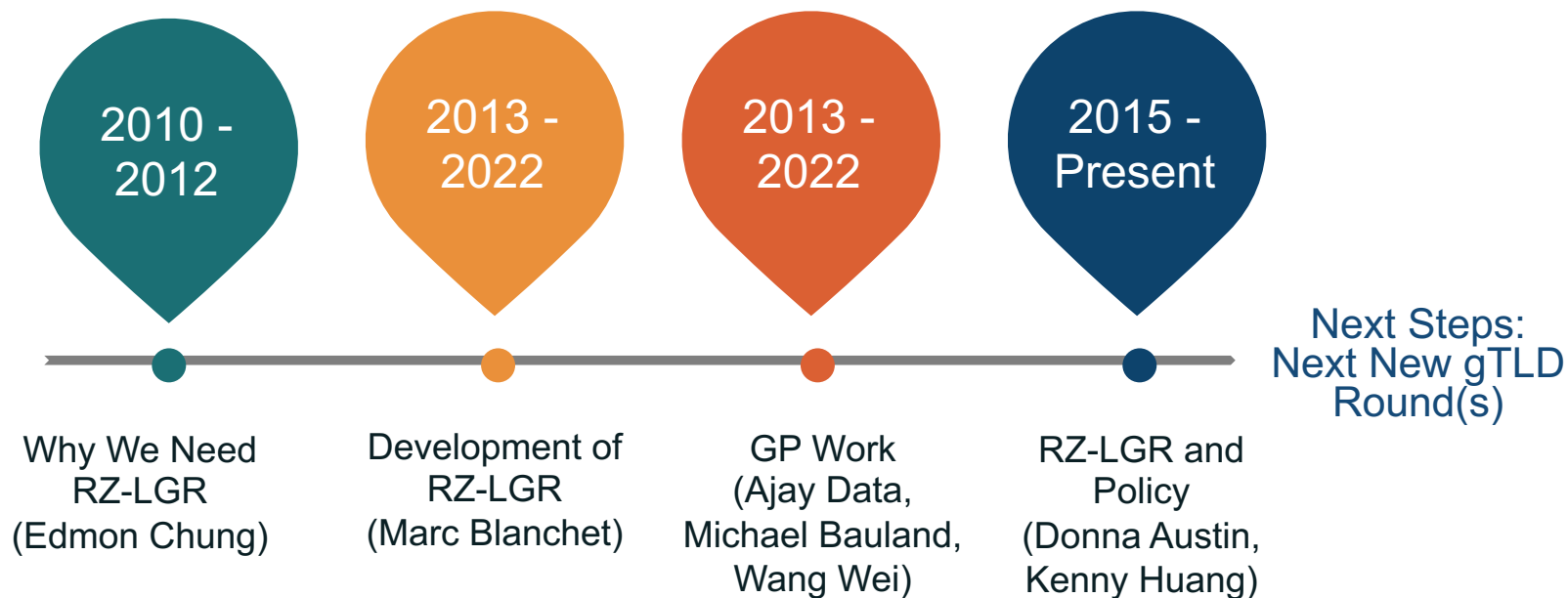

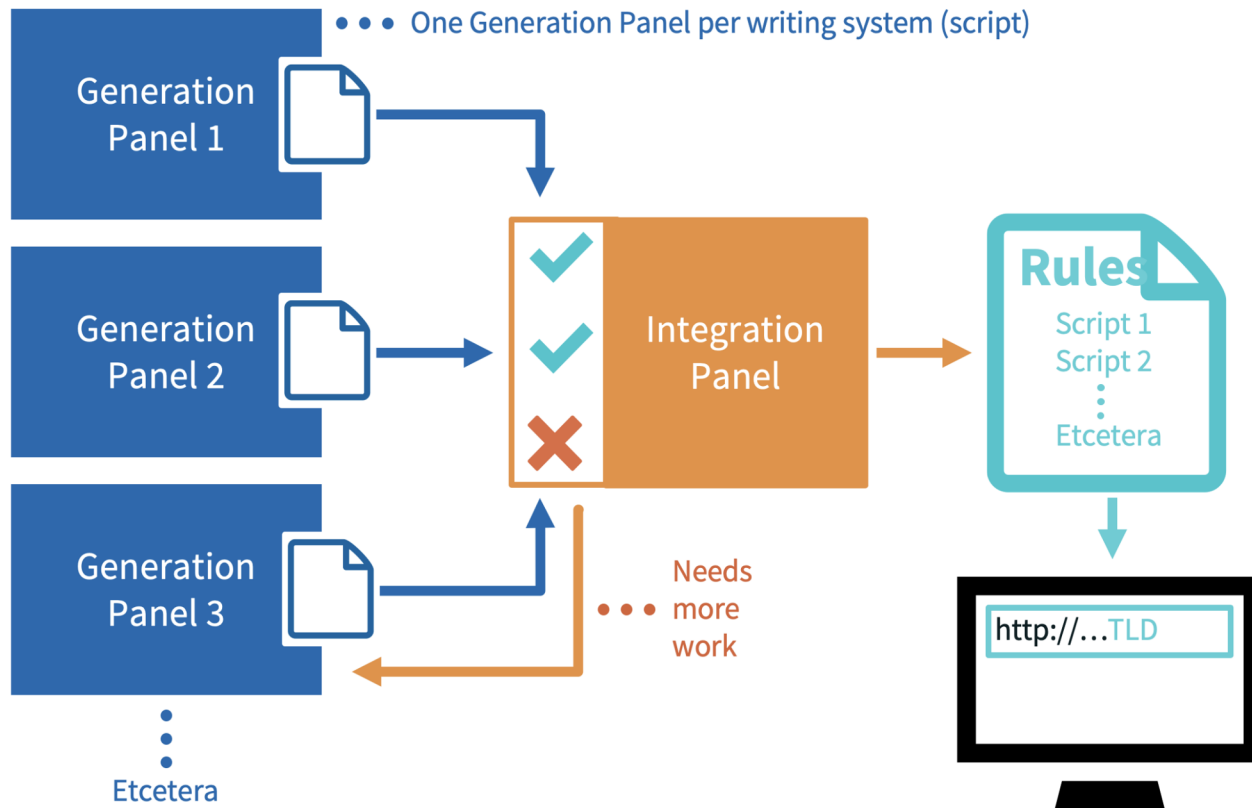


Why RZ-LGR is Needed

Generation Panel Experiences

How RZ-LGR is Being Considered in Policy

Consideration of RZ-LGR by IDN EPDP: Draft Rec Samples

RZ-LGR be the sole source for calculating variant labels and disposition values for existing delegated gTLDs*

- Application submission system issues warning when **algorithmic checking** finds non-compliance with RZ-LGR
- **Limited challenge mechanism for DNS Stability Review** applies in cases where applicant believes label is incorrectly assessed as “invalid”



*SubPro PDP recommends RZ-LGR for generation of **future** gTLDs and variants

Grandfather existing gTLDs and delegated / allocated variant labels not validated by a proposed RZ-LGR update

- GPs and Integration Panel make best effort to **retain full backward compatibility**
- GP identifies **security/stability risks** and **actions to mitigate risks** associated with grandfathering



Single character gTLDs only be allowed for limited script and language where a character is an ideograph**

- **Pending:** Work with Chinese, Japanese, and Korean GPs to develop mechanism or criteria to identify **a specific list of allowable characters** for single-character TLDs



**Consistent with SubPro PDP recommendation
